For immediate release – Terragon Environmental Technologies Inc. is pleased to announce that they have gone into Contract with Maersk Line Limited, to supply a MAGS V8 for the m/v Cragside; one of the US government vessels managed for the Military Sealift Command (MSC).

The Cragside is a Special Warfare Support vessel, currently under conversion. The ship may carry over 200 troops at any time. MAGS will be the main technology onboard for the conversion of shipboard garbage into energy. The MAGS version 8 has many upgrades including an automated biochar removal system, larger loading drum lid, increased capacity, lower weight and smaller footprint, and has an overall lower cost than its predecessor.

"We are excited about this new contract, and see this as another sign that the marine industry is moving towards more energy efficient, and better environmentally performing technologies for the conversion of shipboard waste into energy" states Andrew Korney, Director of Sales for Terragon. "With the development of new regulation for gasification systems underway at IMO, it is understandable shipowners are looking towards future compliance."
